Dear Parent/Guardian,

Re: End of Year Arrangements – Early Finish Times

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you of some important operational arrangements taking place in the coming weeks as we approach the end of the academic year.

As you are aware, we are currently undergoing significant building and refurbishment works across the school site. While these works will ultimately improve our facilities and learning environment, they are presently limiting the amount of usable space available for teaching and other activities.

Alongside this, students in Years 7 to 10 will commence a rigorous internal assessment period from Monday 2nd June 2025. These assessments are essential in tracking student progress and preparing for the academic challenges of the next school year. Many schools in the local area also make these arrangements to facilitate phases of whole school assessments taking place.

In response to these combined pressures, we have made the decision that from **Monday 2nd June–Thursday 10th July**, students in **Years 7–10** will finish the school day at the slightly earlier time of **2.25pm**. This will allow us to manage both the logistical limitations on-site and ensure that students can complete their assessments in a calm, well-structured environment.

Please note the following additional arrangements:

- After school clubs will run 2.25pm-3.15pm.
- Compulsory Study will continue from Monday 2nd June until Thursday 26th June. The timings after half term will be 2.25pm-3.15pm. If your child is to attend Compulsory Study, you will receive a separate letter by Friday 23rd May.
- Our Extended School Provision will remain in place until 5.00pm Monday-Thursdays for families of Year 7 and Year 8 students who wish to take up this offer. This provision will be supervised and provide a space for students to read, complete homework, or engage in quiet study and activities.
