Would you like to be in a professional dance show as part of Kensington and Chelsea Festival?

Where All Paths Lead is a new outdoor dance show from 2Faced Dance company. They are looking for **approx. 20 participants** age **12+**, with different life experiences and movement abilities for an exciting outdoor dance performance taking place this **July** as part of the **Kensington and Chelsea Festival**.

The performance of **Where All Paths Lead**, explores how our bodies work together to form identities and communities and features the company's **6 male dancers** and **1 live drummer**. Using a range of dance styles including **contemporary, parkour, breakdance** and **contact work**, the piece sees the dancers explore the different pathways that we journey through life, ultimately bringing us back home.

There are two sections of the work which will be devised and created by the **project participants**, alongside the company and then performed at the Festival in July. Rehearsals will be **relaxed, fun and friendly** and we welcome both those with lots of **dance/movement** experience and those with very little. All participants will be provided with a costume for the performances. 2Faced Dance staff are DBS checked.

Places are limited to a maximum of 20 and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
