Summer Holidays

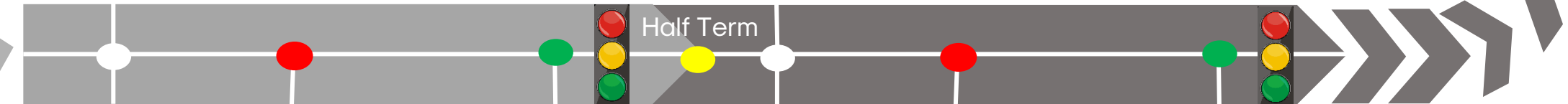
Summer Half Term One: Viewpoints and perspectives

Challenge: Complete an unseen poem essay question from the booklet.

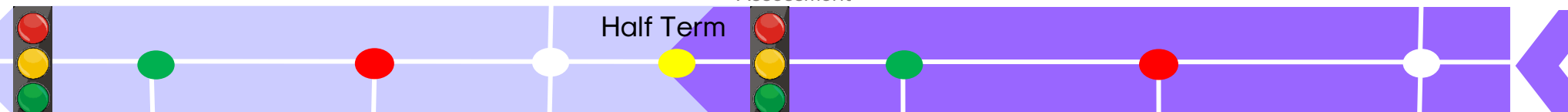
Easter Holidays

Prepare by researching poetic movements and their conventions: Romanticism, Realism, Post-Modernism.

Challenge: Choose two poems from the anthology and compare/contrast the similarities/differences between them.

Support: Use your poetry glossary.

Retrieval: What is enjambment and caesura?

Challenge: Compare Shakespeare's presentation of Desdemona and Emilia.

Support: Watch scenes on YouTube.

Retrieval: What is the difference between a monologue and a soliloquy?
